- share in the wisdom of God existing within each person.

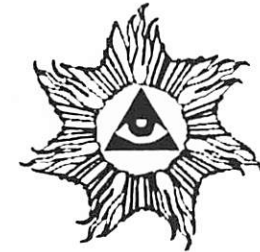

NSSC's PURPOSE

For over 60 years, NSSC has served as a beacon for those in search of a meaningful relationship with God, a loving interaction with others, and a genuine understanding of their own personal power.

We provide a wide range of classes, seminars and workshops, worship and healing services, and spiritual counseling.

SCHOOL OF SPIRITUAL SCIENCE

The School of Spiritual Science, which is central to our mission, presents a curriculum of practical spirituality addressing ways to live in a world of peace, abundance, health, loving relationships, success and fulfillment.

Founded in 1970, this program is ideal for those wishing to explore their spiritual nature as well as serious students seeking the path of ministerial service and ordination. Meditation is an integral part of all four years of study, providing a foundation to the entire program. Study materials include works of leading teachers and philosophers of metaphysics, ancient and modern.

The School features four years of study:

I. Exploring Intuition and Psychic Phenomena

In the first year, students are introduced to subtle energy, the I AM power, the functions and purpose of the Soul, Hermetic teachings and beginning psychic development. Daily meditation exercises lead to the experience and understanding of inner contact and of the indestructible and immutable nature of the Soul.

During the second semester, students explore the Soul's purpose for incarnating. The esoteric process of dying

and the after-life are examined to aid and comfort the self and others in situations relating to death. The student creates a personal obituary and participates in introspective journaling. Astrology and the nature of personal and cosmic symbols are also investigated.

II. Tracing the Golden Thread of Truth through Religion

In the second year, students examine the roots, evolution, and unifying concepts of the world religions through a study of Buddhism, Christianity, Confucianism, Hinduism, Islam, Judaism, and Taoism. Students research and present written reports on many ancient and modern belief systems, including Church of the Latter Day Saints (Mormon), Christian Science, the Greek philosophies, Jainism, Mayan, Mithraic, Native American, Society of Friends (Quaker), Wiccan, and Yoruba beliefs, among others.

Students also attend service at a place of worship not of their own faith and share their experience with the class. Study of esoteric interpretations of the *Old and New Testaments* and the *Bhagavad Gita*, teachings of yogic philosophy, and explorations into the Abraham techniques of deliberate creation are highlighted.

The interdependence of thoughts, words, emotions, and actions, and their direct influence on life experience is examined and applied. Meditation assignments develop an understanding of the interrelationship between the personality and spiritual development. Students also meditate on symbols associated with world religions.

III. Preparing and Perfecting the Healing Channel

The healing of the self and others is the focus of the third year. In-depth study of the seven vital psychic power centers (chakras), physical anatomy, and the functions of the endocrine system are explored. Texts range from ancient teachings and mystery schools to current writers and recent medical breakthroughs.

Study includes vibrational healing, which enables students to break through old habit patterns and belief systems. Meditations attune the student to the subtle bodies and the power centers.

Students write and present a Healing Prayer and are trained to participate with ministers during the demonstration of clairvoyance at Sunday Services. Specialized etheric healing techniques are taught and students learn to understand and develop the ability to hold a clear, focused channel for healing energies.

IV. Wisdom Teachings

The fourth year provides deeper growth and development through study of the ancient mysteries and philosophies. Highlighted are esoteric explorations of the creation and evolution of the human race, the earth, and the universe, as well as the individual's place and connection with the universal powers.

The influence of cosmic energies on peoples and nations, and the study of individual and cosmic initiations are explored through the Kabbalah, the Tarot, and other ancient wisdom teachings. The workings of magic are taught.

Meditations concentrate on Universal, Kabbalistic, and Archetypal symbols, the Tree of Life, and the Tarot. Study of the influence of the Seven Rays in the Aquarian Age enhances an appreciation of how to work with the incoming cosmic energies.

Ministerial Training: A separate course in Ministerial training ensures responsible and confident response to a call for ministerial service.

Fall Classes begin the first week in September after Labor Day, and are held one evening per week, 6:30 - 9:30 PM, for two 18-week semesters. Registration takes place the end of August.
